

## 2022-2023 OP South Rotary CAPS Scholarship Instructions

Rotary International and Overland Park South Rotary foster the ideal of Service above self while maintaining high ethical standards. Five areas of service focus include:

1. Club Service – contribute to the strength of our local clubs
2. Vocational Service – use your job skills to benefit others
3. Community Service – improve the lives of others in our community
4. International Service – exemplifies our global reach
5. Youth Service recognizes the importance of empowering youth and young professionals

The Four-Way Test is a nonpartisan and nonsectarian ethical guide for Rotarians to use for their personal and professional relationships. The test is, of the things we think, say, or do

1. Is it the TRUTH?
2. Is it FAIR to all concerned?
3. Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?

OP South Rotary offers two scholarships to CAPS students in the amounts of \$1,500 and \$750.

With Service above self in mind, please complete the following scholarship application materials.

- Submission materials must be submitted by the due date of **March 3, 2023**, by 5:00 pm.
- The two finalists will present to the OP South membership, who will vote on the first and second-place awards at the meeting on Wednesday, April 12, 2023.

Complete the online application. This includes a video submission and a resume.

### **VIDEO:**

In a video not to exceed three (3) Minutes, help the selection committee get to know you by telling us the following.

1. We'd like to know about your volunteer activities. In addition, what meaningful and ongoing volunteer work have you done? Finally, how do your volunteer choices align with the Rotary introductory information?
2. What is your educational goal, and plan to achieve it? At this point, you may not know your educational goal and plan. That's fine. Instead, please tell us your plan to determine your educational goal.
3. What is your career goal, and plan to achieve it? At this point, you may not know your career goal and plan. That's fine. Instead, let us know your plan to figure out your career goal.
4. How will the CAPS Scholarship make a difference in your future?

Video criteria: we are not looking for a professionally developed video. Your Smart Phone video recorder is fine. However, we are looking to see if you included the criteria above. Students who do not clearly address questions 1 – 4 and provide all submission materials will not be considered further.

Assessment criteria weighting:

- 30% question 1
- 20% question 2
- 15% question 3
- 10% question 4
- 13% Ability to clearly communicate
- 12% Professionalism
